

DEPARTMENT 003 – SWINE

Fair Year: 2019

Entries must be made by July 31 of exhibit year.
Open to youth enrolled in the 4-H Swine project or youth of other groups doing equivalent work.
Judging will be on Friday beginning at 8:30 am.
Hogs that weigh under 240 pounds will be shown in the junior class light weight division.
Note: Market Animal Sale requirements are listed in a separate document.

No hay or bedding may be stored in the barns.
Bred and owned is defined as the dam/mother needs to be owned by the exhibitor or immediate family member.

This is a terminal show and all exhibited swine will need to be slaughtered immediately following the fair.

Rules Governing Swine Exhibits

- See health regulations.
- Swine shown in Junior Fair not eligible for Open Class.
- The Danish system of judging will be used.

All exhibitors: See Animal Health Regulations for Fairs and Shows in Wisconsin.

DIVISION 23 – MARKET HOGS

Class No. Premiums: \$6.00 - \$5.00 - \$4.00 - \$3.00
Only animals that are 240-310 pounds will be eligible for the sale.

- Class No.** Premiums: \$6.00 - \$5.00 - \$4.00 - \$3.00
- Market hog (classes divided by weight)
 - Carcass hog – 240# or over. Carcass placings will be determined by ultrasound scanning.
 - Bred and owned

DIVISION 24 – SHOWMANSHIP (Swine)

Danish Judging
Entry must be on an entry blank.
Exhibitors must show their own animals in showmanship classes.

Open to 4-H and FFA members
(Grade just completed.)

- Class No.** Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.50 - \$2.00 - \$1.50
- Grades 3-4
 - Grades 5-6
 - Grades 7-8
 - Grades 9-10
 - Grades 11 and above

Show a Pig Class – no pre-registration necessary.
This class is for any swine exhibitor, who is unable to show their own animal. They may show another exhibitor's animal.

Pre 4-H Hog Class

There will be a special swine class open to youth not old enough to show in the 4-H and FFA classes. This class will be held immediately following the swine showmanship classes. Youth must have completed Kindergarten to participate.

Herdsmen/Barn Award

Compeer Financial, Chilton, WI, will sponsor herdsman awards for the top two swine exhibits. Awards will be determined on the following basis:

- The cleanliness and neatness at all times of livestock and premises and the care and management of feed and storage and waste disposal.
- Identification of individual animals and their exhibitor.
