- in the junior class light weight division. Note: Market Animal Sale requirements are
- listed in a separate document.

No hay or bedding may be stored in the barns. Bred and owned is defined as the dam/mother needs to be owned by the exhibitor or immediate family member.

This is a non-terminal show. There will be no trucking set up by the Market Animal Committee.

Rules Governing Swine Exhibits

- a. See health regulations.
- b. Swine shown in Junior Fair not eligible for Open Class.
- c. The Danish system of judging will be used.

All exhibitors: See Animal Health Regulations for Fairs and Shows in Wisconsin.

All swine must have a PRRS (Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome) and PEDv (Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea virus) test of the herd or origin within 90 days of the exhibition. Include test date, type and results on the CVI.

 For swine originating from herds with positive tests, include the herd plan number of the CVI. • A statement that the veterinarian has inspected the entire herd of origin within the past 30 days and that no clinical signs of PRRS and PEDv or any other apparent disease was present at the time of inspection.
