

DEPARTMENT OC 103 – SWINE

Fair Year: 2021

Entries must be made by July 31 of exhibit year.

All breeds show together in market classes.

All swine need a visible ID tag number in their ear.

Open Class Swine Exhibitors must have completed five year old kindergarten.

This is a non-terminal show. There will be no trucking set up by the Market Animal Committee.

Premiums: \$6.00–\$5.00–\$4.00–\$3.00

All exhibitors: See Animal Health Regulations for Fairs and Shows in Wisconsin.

All swine must have a PRRS (Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome) and PEDv (Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea virus) test of the herd or origin within 90 days of the exhibition. Include test date, type and results on the CVI.

- For swine originating from herds with positive tests, include the herd plan number of the CVI.

A statement that the veterinarian has inspected the entire herd of origin within the past 30 days and that no clinical signs of PRRS and PEDv or any other apparent disease was present at the time of inspection.
