Exhibitors must bring own computer to display multimedia entries during judging or will be evaluated on printout.

Poster size: 14"x22". Tri-fold displays are not allowed.

## DIVISION 195 – COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY

Class No. Premiums: \$2.00 - \$1.75 - \$1.50 - \$1.25

1. A computer exhibit made in school for grade or credit
2. Poster, display, or multimedia presentation on mechanics, electronics, or technology options related to a computer
3. Multimedia presentation (minimum of 10 slides)
4. Basic website; include description of steps required in developing it
5. Database or spreadsheet, with at least 3 reports or graphs generated from the data
6. T-shirt, designed and printed using computer graphics and/or text
7. Printed storybook, with original story written by member and illustrated with drawings, clip art, or photos
8. Newsletter exhibit using desktop publishing program and graphics
9. Take a photo and design a series of 4 new photos using special effects. Mount on 14"x22" poster
10. Computerized banner
11. Computerized poster, pamphlet, or power point on any 4-H topic
12. Two different computerized greeting cards with envelopes
13. Any other exhibit featuring computer art/graphics
14. Any other computer related exhibit
