# **DEPARTMENT 018 – CULTURAL ARTS**

Entries must be made by July 31 of exhibit year. Open to youth enrolled in the 4-H Cultural Arts. Folk Arts, or Latino Arts project or youth of other groups doing equivalent work.

Face-to-Face judging the Saturday before the fair, 9:00 am - 2:00 pm, Youth Building.

Exhibitors are limited to a maximum of 15 entries in Department 018. If more than 15 Department 018 entries are listed on the entry blank, only the first 15 will be entered into the computer. The remaining entries will not be accepted.

Exhibits will be judged on total presentation (ie picture has matting, stitchery is finished in a frame, made into a pillow, etc., articles are clean and

All pieces of artwork must be presented in a way that they can be easily and securely displayed. For this reason, artwork done on PAPER must be mounted on to at least a piece of posterboard to prevent damage during displaying. Do not use good mats as the matting will be pinned. All other articles (including canvases with wooden frames) MUST be equipped with a sturdy hanging device such as metal hangers attached with nails. Masking tape, duct tape, string, and pop tops are NOT sturdy enough, and therefore not allowed.

Designs must be original or adapted from another source. Avoid using copyrighted material.

Projects not following the guidelines will be downgraded one placing.
